

On May 25th, 2021 the Douglas County mask mandate expires. Due to the nature of our business and the many immunocompromised patients we serve, we will continue to require masks in our office. As a healthcare facility, we make every effort to keep our patients and staff safe and for now, this means we will continue to require masks to be seen. As new information from the CDC is released, we will make adjustments to our policies as necessary. We appreciate your continued understanding and patience during the everchanging pandemic. More details below:

At Advanced Dental Sleep Treatment Center, we are committed to keeping our team and our patients healthy and safe. Following is our protocol for in-office appointments.

Masks are required. There may be times during your appointment where we ask you to temporarily remove it. However, we ask that everyone wear one when entering the office and at all other times unless requested by our team to remove it. If you decline to wear a mask, we will ask you to reschedule. If you need a mask, we will provide one to you.

Before coming into the office you must confirm that you do not have flu/cold like symptoms, have not been in contact with someone with COVID-19, and are not awaiting COVID-19 test results.

We will bring you into a clinical room as soon as we can, but if you do need to utilize the waiting room, we ask that you sit 3 ft away from others. All surfaces are disinfected thoroughly throughout the day. We also ask that you either come yourself, or limit to one other person who accompanies you. If someone does accompany you, they will follow the same in-office guidelines.

Again, thank you for your patience and trust in us during these challenging times. Your safety and our staff's safety are our top priority. We will update this document as needed.
